The **critical cyborg** final review is going to be on Monday December 3rd.
We will be exhibiting and discussing your drawings and models in creature groups.

The sequence for the review will be by animals, from tropics to arctic;

1.00pm-4.20pm BAT, BEE, FROG, SILKWORM, BUTTERFLY

food will be served between 4.30-5.00pm

5.00pm-8.20pm SWALLOW, CROW, PIGEON, SQUIRREL, PUFFIN

We are requiring that, in addition to the atlas_bestiary, you each show a sequence of process models, nest drawing, 4 sections, 2 plans and a self defined item. This last item might be an atmospheric or diagrammatic collage image, audio, live demo or film, depending on the needs to explain your proposal. If it is in 4d media form this must be on an ipad pinned to the panel. The drawings/drafts that you have made of the nest and proposed structure (in section/plan) will be scanned, boosted for intensity and plotted individually for review. **All** work will be collected and you will have to leave studio at 6.00pm on Sunday December 2nd.

You will host a conversation as a creature group. You will start with a provocative narrative, coordinated between all in the group. It will not be a series of individual presentations but your work will act as a prompt for an expansive, theoretically driven and highly speculative discussion.

In the week after Thanksgiving, as a completely separate exercise we are having individual reviews with you, ML and your instructor. These will take place on Monday 11/26, Wednesday 11/28 and Friday 11/30. There is a schedule below and we will run on time. Make sure that all your work is on RTB so that we can use this format to reference the work.
